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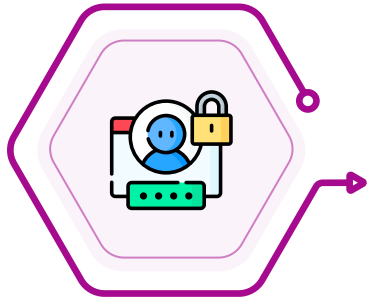


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Nvidia's Rapid Response: Introducing NemoClaw and OpenShell Runtime

How OpenClaw Propels Nvidia's AI-Driven Growth and NVDA Stock

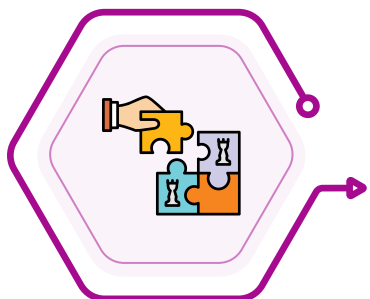

With agents requiring around 1 million times more tokens than earlier AI models, Nvidia is set to benefit from the exponential growth of AI demand. At GTC, Nvidia also unveiled the Vera Rubin platform, a specialized system designed for agentic AI workloads. The platform promises to deliver up to 10 times the inference throughput per watt compared to prior systems, with key partnerships including Anthropic, OpenAI, Meta, and Microsoft already on board.

NVDA Stock Outlook: Strong Buy Recommendations and Growing Market Demand

As Nvidia positions itself at the forefront of agentic AI, the company's stock outlook remains positive. Out of the 49 analysts covering NVDA stock, 44 recommend a "Strong Buy," three recommend a "Moderate Buy," and only one analyst recommends a "Strong Sell." The average stock price target stands at \$265.97, well above the current price of \$179.
