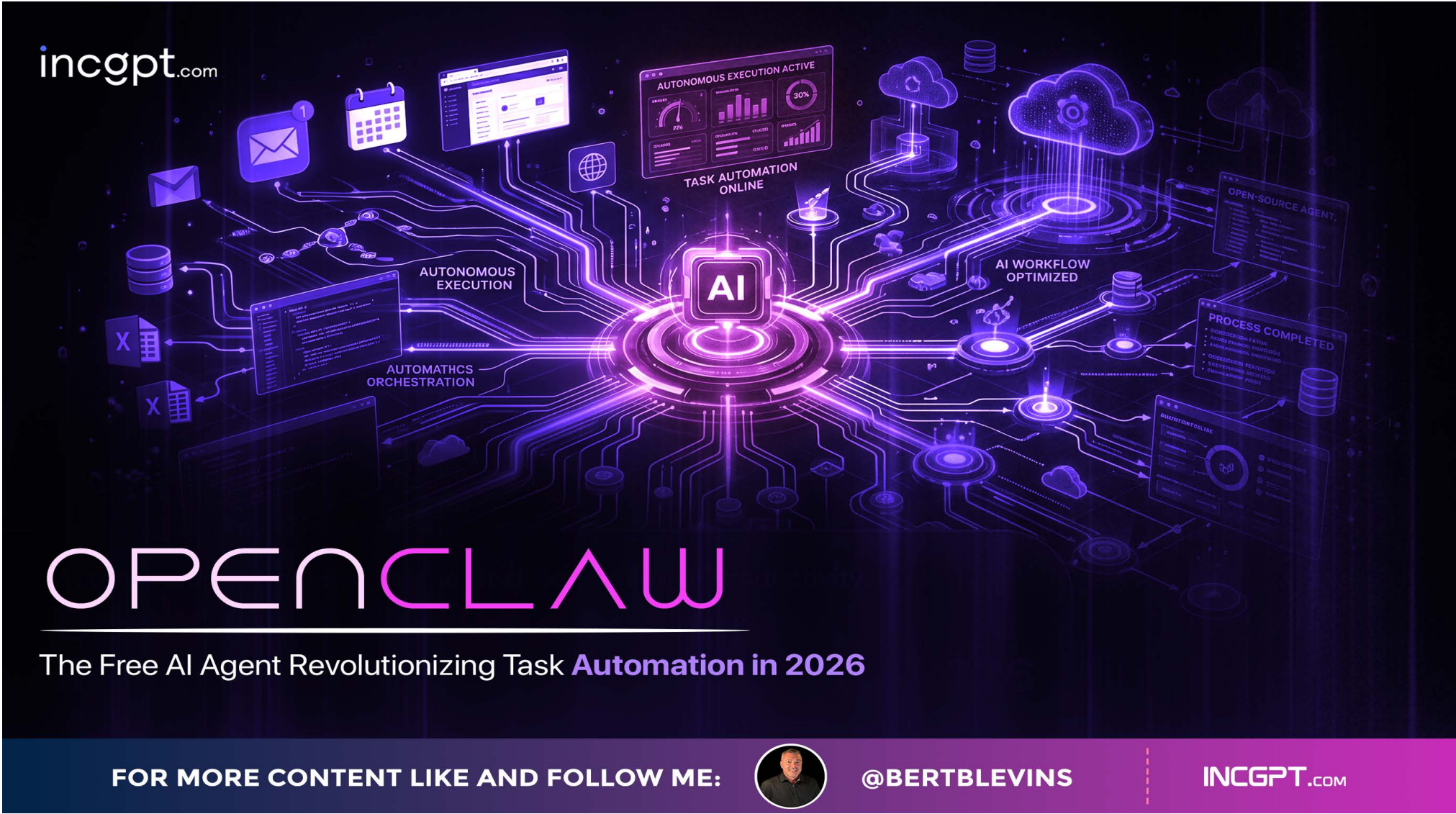


# OpenClaw:

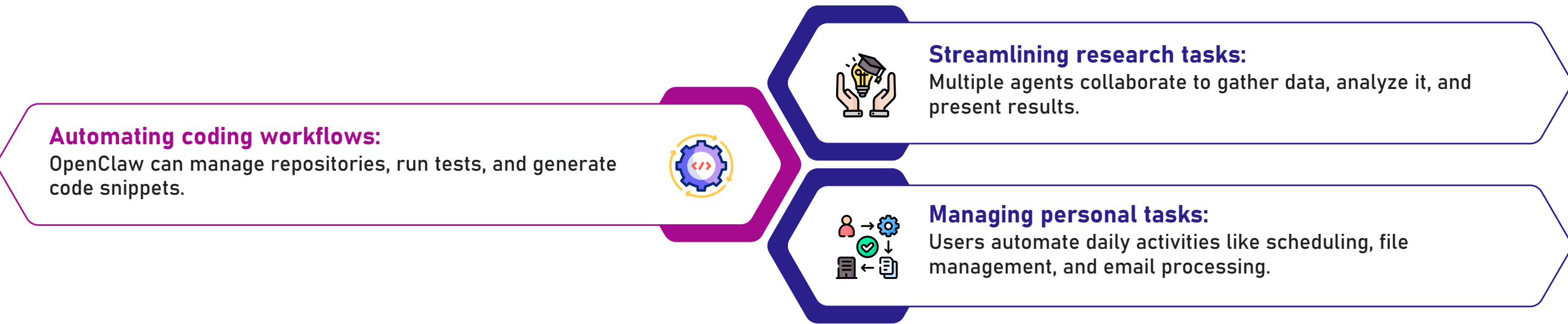

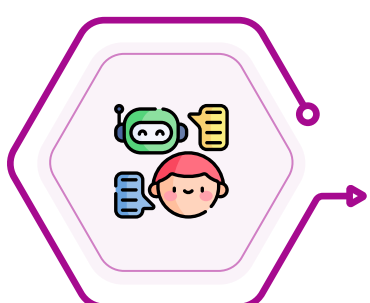

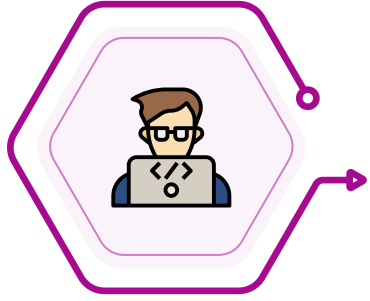
